Cultar Cinnidhean na h-Alba - The Scottish Clans

- 1. From the Gaelic word 'clann' (children)

- 3. Given many Scots their surnames/provided a great deal of family pride/produced a fierce sense of belonging many people regard membership of a clan as a vital part of their Scottish heritage.
- 4. a) Chief
 - b) The chief would have been like a father figure to his clansfolk and would make sure they had enough suitable land to enable them to provide for their family. Rule over and look after their clan.
- 5. They were loyal to their chief, and would be ready to fight any battles he wanted them to. They would also take turns working on the chief's land and would give him gifts of food and provisions.
- 6. Saw it as a threat to their rule and their plans to join England and Scotland together. The King wanted to control the clans to make them swear allegiance to him rather than their chief.
- 7. a) King James tricked the chiefs and forced them to agree to a list of new laws.
 - b) This resulted in the whole clan structure beginning to fall apart and Gaelic language and culture began its slow demise.
- 8. The old clan system no longer exists. Each clan still has a chief, but usually the chief doesn't have a Scottish accent, let alone the ability to speak any Gaelic.
