Pasgan-obrach (Ionnsachadh & Comas-obrach)

Anns a' phasgan-obrach gheibhear piosan obrach anns na ceithir sgilean: Èisteachd, Leughadh, Sgrìobhadh agus Labhairt.

Tha na piosan obrach stèidhichte air **Ionnsachadh** agus **Comas-obrach**, ged a dh'fhaodadh an dà cho-theacs eile (**Cultar** agus **Sòisealtas**) nochdadh gu ìre cuideachd.

Study Pack (Learning and Employability)

This pack contains tasks in the 4 skill areas: Listening, Reading, Writing and Talking. The main contexts covered in this pack are **Learning** and **Employability**, although the other two contexts of **Culture** and **Society** may also appear within texts, to a lesser extent.

The tasks are designed to reflect the level and style of N5 assessment and examination tasks. Therefore, pupils and teachers may find this pack useful for exam and assessment revision towards the end of the year.

Advice for pupils:

You should read through and consider the questions for passages **before** listening.

You can listen to the passage as often as needed. However, in an assessment situation, you will only hear the Gaelic **three** times. So, if you want to use this as exam practice, you might limit the number of times you listen.

Èisteachd 1 Monologue (Learning)

Susie talks about her experience of school and how she deals with exam pressure.

Am-bliadhna tha mi a' dèanamh seachd cuspairean aig ìre Nàiseanta 5. 'S e Spòrs agus Ceòl na cuspairean as fheàrr leam. Tha mi measail air Eachdraidh cuideachd. Bidh mi a' dèanamh Eachdraidh tro mheadhan na Gàidhlig. Tha mi ag obair gu cruaidh airson nan deuchainnean an-dràsta oir tha mi ag iarraidh cùrsa Spòrs a dhèanamh anns a' cholaiste.

Bidh mi tric a' faireachdainn iomagaineach mu obair sgoile agus deuchainnean. Bidh eacarsaich agus ceòl gam chuideachadh gu mòr. Bidh mi ag eacarsaich a h-uile latha. Nuair a nì mi eacarsaich, bidh mi a' faireachdainn nas fheàrr. Bidh mi a' cluich na fìdhle ann an còmhlan-ciùil agus bidh sin gam dhèanamh toilichte.

Ma tha thu ag iarraidh bodhaig agus inntinn fhallain, tha e cudromach gum bi balans agad eadar cur-seachadan agus obair-sgoile agus gum faigh thu cadal gu leòr. Tha mi an dòchas gun dèan mi gu math anns na deuchainnean agam. Bidh mi toilichte nuair a bhios iad deiseil.



Listening passage 2 Dialogue (Learning & Employability)

Sanjay Singh is being interviewed about his experience of learning Gaelic and his career in Television.

Feasgar math, a Shanjay. Tha obair mhath agad aig BBC Alba. An inns thu dhomh beagan mu dheidhinn sin?

Innsidh gu dearbh. 'S e neach-naidheachd a th' annam an seo aig a' BhBC ann an Glaschu. Bidh mi a' leughadh nan naidheachdan Gàidhlig air an telebhisean a h-uile feasgar aig sia uairean.

Cuin a thòisich thu air an obair?

Thòisich mi ann an dà mhìle 's a naoi-deug nuair a bha mi deiseil anns a' cholaiste. Bha mi nam oileanach aig Sabhal Mòr Ostaig.

An do rinn thu Gàidhlig anns an sgoil idir?

Cha do rinn idir. Nuair a dh'fhàg mi an sgoil, bha mi ag iarraidh Gàidhlig ionnsachadh agus chaidh mi gu Sabhal Mòr Ostaig. Rinn mi cùrsa Gàidhlig agus bha mi fileanta ann am bliadhna. An uair sin anns an dàrna bliadhna rinn mi an cùrsa Tbh aig a' cholaiste.

An robh e doirbh Gàidhlig ionnsachadh?

Cha robh! Aig Sabhal Mòr Ostaig bidh a h-uile duine a' bruidhinn Gàidhlig fad na h-ùine — anns a' chlas, anns a' chanteen agus aig cèilidhean. Cha robh duine sam bith a' bruidhinn Beurla idir. Bha na tidsearan sgoinneil cuideachd. Bha sinn a' cluich gheamannan agus bha na clasaichean spòrsail. Mar sin, bha e furasta Gàidhlig ionnsachadh!

Tha sin mìorbhaileach math! An robh thu math air cànan anns an sgoil?

Cha robh! Rinn mi Fraingis gu Nàiseanta 5 ach chan eil facal agam a-nis oir cha robh sinn a' bruidhinn Fraingis gu leòr anns a' chlas. Ma tha thu ag iarraidh cànan ionnsachadh gu ceart, feumaidh tu a bhith ga bhruidhinn agus ag èisteachd ris fad an latha, a h-uile latha.

A bheil cànan eile agad?

Tha. 'S e Punjabi an dàrna cànan agam. Rugadh agus thogadh mo mhàthair anns na h-Innseachan agus bha sinn a' bruidhinn Punjabi aig an taigh. Mar sin, bha dà chànan agam bhon a bha mi òg — Beurla agus Punjabi.

Tha daoine ag ràdh gu bheil e nas fhasa cànan eile ionnsachadh ma tha dà chanan agad mar-thà. A bheil thu a' smaoinichadh gu bheil sin ceart?

Tha gu dearbh.

Agus a bheil e a' còrdadh riut a bhith ag obair ann an Saoghal na Gàidhlig?

Tha gu mòr. Is toigh leam a bhith a' bruidhinn na Gàidhlig a h-uile latha. Bidh mi ag ionnsachadh fhaclan ùra a h-uile latha. Tha an luchd-obrach aig BBC Alba laghach agus bidh mi a' faighinn air adhart gu math leotha. Tha mi cho toilichte gun do dh'ionnsaich mi Gàidhlig. Ma tha sgoilearan ag iarraidh obair mhath, bu chòir dhaibh Gàidhlig ionnsachadh.

Tapadh leat, a Shanjay. Bha sin gu math inntinneach.
